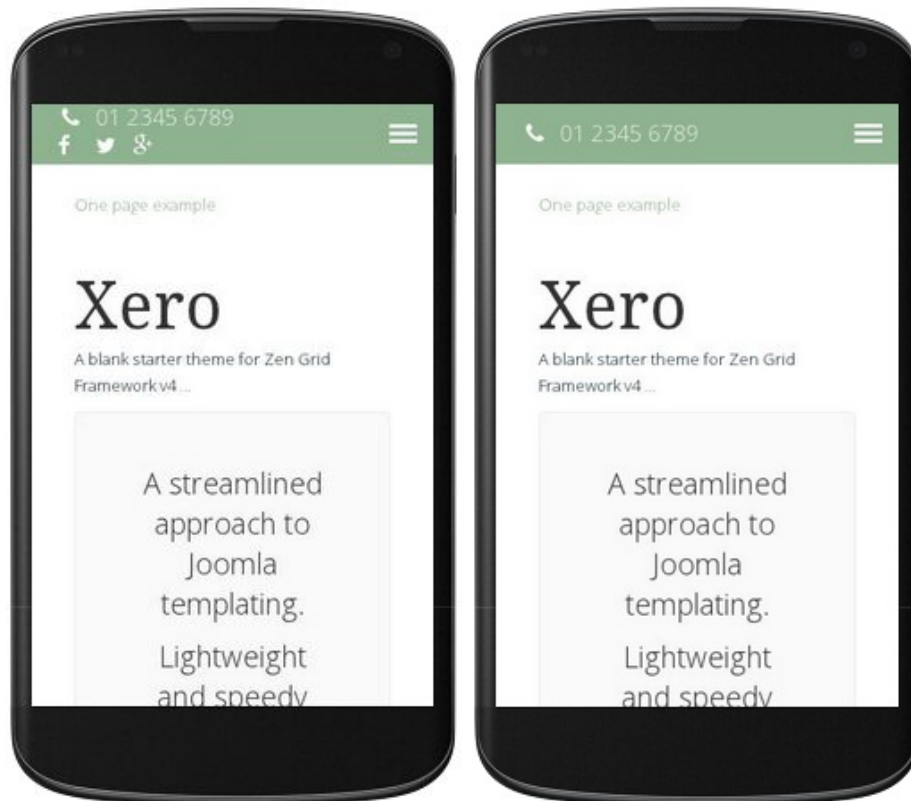

In Template – settings – Mobile Detect

Mobile Detect

When this option is enabled a server side function is used to determine whether the user is on a tablet, phone or other device. Server side applications can increase the loading of the template slightly however it will significantly improve the users experience on these devices. If this option is disabled then content set to be hidden on phones and tablets are simply hidden from view as opposed to not loaded at all. If a row is set to be hidden on a specific device then it will not show on that device regardless of the breakpoints set under the responsive tab. WARNING: This option is not compatible with the Joomla System - Cache plugin which saves copies of pages to be reused for different visitors on different devices.
